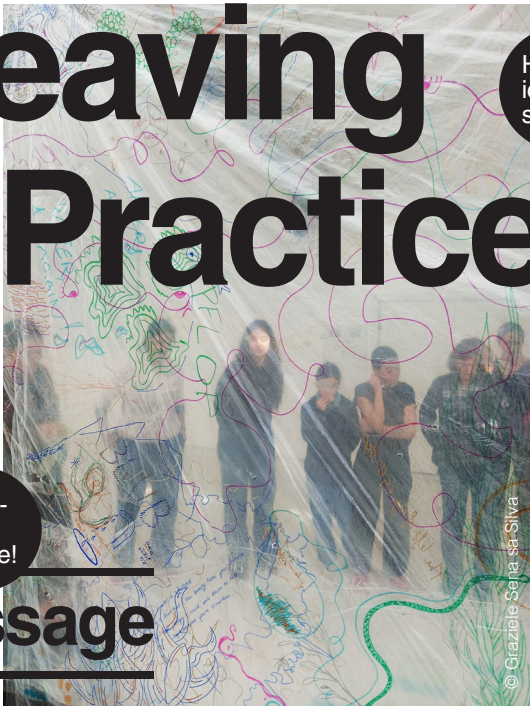

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How might collective listening transform how we relate within the web of human and more-than-human life?

A group of artists, activists, and listeners came together over the course of two months, to explore listening as an artistic practice of building relationships. Starting from the questions—*Which voices go unheard? Which stories are missing?*—the group engaged with listening to connect, imagine, and make other worlds possible.

This process does not follow a single idea or narrative. Instead, it embraces a web of interconnected perspectives—polyphonic, shifting, and entangled like a mycelium. What is emerging is shared soundscape: speculative, multi-voiced, and woven from many threads.

Part of *StraßenKunstFest*, this gathering is an invitation to listen otherwise. Join us in sensing, imagining, and weaving space for what often goes unheard.
